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RESIGNATION OF ATTORNEY AFFIDAVIT PURSUANT TO §2-52(b)

Peter L. Ressler, being duly sworn, does depose and state:

1. I am over 18 years of age and believe in the obligations of an oath.
2. I submit this affidavit in conjunction with my application to resign as an attorney and to waive the right to reply. That resignation, dated March 18, 2016, has been submitted knowingly and voluntarily and of my own free will. It is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

3. I am aware that I have a right to a full evidentiary hearing on this matter with the assistance of an attorney. I waive that right by entering into this Resignation and Waiver.

4. I have not been the subject of coercion nor duress. I am fully aware of the consequences of the Resignation and Waiver.

I have informed Chief Disciplinary Counsel of my violations of the Rules of Professional Conduct, specifically Rule 1.15 and Rule 8.4(4) on this date and have requested the initiation of an investigation into my conduct. That has been submitted to Chief Disciplinary Counsel electronically and by United States Mail. It is my understanding that an investigation will be initiated forthwith.


