IN THE NAME AND BEHALF OF THE CITIZENS OF GEORGIA, CHARGE AND ACCUSE LARRY BUSH HILL with the offense of Influencing Witness [O.C.G.A. 16-10-93(a)] for that the said accused, in the State and County aforesaid, on the 1st day of May, 2017, did, with the intent to deter a witness, to wit: Christy Campbell from testifying freely, fully, and truthfully to a matter pending in the Superior Court of Walker County, to wit: State of Georgia v. Mark Lynn McGill, case number 15-CR-449, offer a benefit, reward and consideration to such witness, when the accused communicated an agreement by Mark Lynn McGill to pay for an attorney to represent Christy Campbell in an unrelated pending case against her, contrary to the laws of said state, the good order, peace and dignity thereof.

COUNT 2

AND THE GRAND JURORS AFORESAID, IN THE NAME AND BEHALF OF THE CITIZENS OF GEORGIA, CHARGE AND ACCUSE LARRY BUSH HILL with the offense of Criminal Attempt to Suborn Perjury [O.C.G.A. 16-10-72] for that the said accused, in the State and County aforesaid, on and about the 1st day of May, 2017, did, with the intent to commit the crime of Subornation of Perjury, commit acts which constituted substantial steps towards the commission of said crime when he attempted to procure and induce another, to wit: Christy Campbell, to commit the offense of Perjury [O.C.G.A. 16-10-70] by meeting with Christy Campbell on two occasions, discussing her knowledge of matters material to the issue and point in question in a judicial proceeding, to wit: Walker County Superior Court case number 15-CR-449, State of Georgia vs. Mark Lynn McGill, preparing and procuring a written affidavit containing materially false statements which were contrary to her statements to the accused at their first meeting and to her prior statements concerning the same matters, and delivering said false written affidavit to Christy Campbell at their second meeting for the purpose of her executing the same as a sworn affidavit containing false statements material to the issue and point in question in Walker County Superior Court case number 15-CR-449, State of Georgia vs. Mark Lynn McGill, to wit: that she did not see the alleged victim's mouth on Mark McGill's penis and that the alleged victim had stated to her that he had lied about the incident at issue in said case because Mark McGill had taken his video game system away from him and that said victim had stated to her that he had never placed his mouth on Mark McGill's penis and that Mark McGill had never placed his mouth on the victim's penis, contrary to the laws of said State, the good order, peace and dignity thereof.
