The Appellate Division of the Supreme Court, First Judicial Department,  
pursuant to the authority vested in it,

Hereby, effectively immediately, amends Part 600 of Title 22 of the official  
Compilation of Code, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York, as follows  
(additions in test are indicated by underlying and deletions by ~~strikethrough~~):

**Part 600. APPEALS**

\* \* \*

**§ 600.17. Fees of the Clerk of the Court**

- (a) In addition to the fees provided for in (22 NYCRR) § 1250.17, pursuant to  
Judiciary Law § 265, the clerk of the court is entitled to receive in advance  
the following fees on behalf of the State of New York:
- (1) For an embossed and engraved certificate of admission as an  
attorney and counselor at law, twenty-five dollars;
  - (2) ~~For a certificate of good standing, ten dollars;~~
  - (32) For furnishing a hard or digital copy, certified or uncertified,  
of an opinion, decision, order, record, or other paper in his  
or her custody, one dollar for the first page and 50 cents for  
each additional page; and

(43) No charge shall be made for furnishing a copy of the order, opinion or decision of the court to any party to an appeal or proceeding pending in the court.
