NOTICE

The New York City Civil Court has calendared for dismissal, pursuant to CPLR 3215(c), all nonpayment proceedings in the Housing Part wherein:

- an index number was purchased prior to January 15, 2022;
- a petition was filed seeking a judgment solely on grounds that the respondent(s) defaulted in the payment of rent;
- no responsive papers were filed and no application for a default judgment was made; and
- the proceeding is not stayed (i.e., temporarily suspended).

Interested parties who wish to have the proceeding remain active must file with the Clerk's Office in the appropriate county: (1) a motion demonstrating sufficient cause why the petition should not be dismissed; or (2) a stipulation where all parties are represented by counsel, agreeing to keep the proceeding active. Such a motion or stipulation should be filed via NYSCEF or in person at the Clerk's Office in the appropriate county.

Failure to file the motion or stipulation on or before April 19, 2024 shall result in the administrative dismissal of the action.

Additionally, the New York City Civil Court has calendared for dismissal all Landlord & Tenant proceedings in the Housing Part wherein:

- an index number purchased prior to January 15, 2022;
- there was a court date on or before February 15, 2023;
- there has been no disposition;
- there is no future court activity scheduled;
- there are no decisions pending with a judge; and
- the index number is not stayed.

Interested parties who wish to have the proceeding remain active must file with the Clerk's Office in the appropriate county: (1) a motion demonstrating sufficient cause why the petition should not be dismissed; or (2) a stipulation where all parties are represented by counsel. Such a motion or stipulation should be filed via NYSCEF or in person at the Clerk's Office in the appropriate county.

Failure to file the motion or stipulation on or before April 19, 2024 shall result in the administrative dismissal of the action.
