**ORDER GRANTING COLOMBO'S MOTION TO AMEND TO ASSERT A
CLAIM FOR PUNITIVE DAMAGES AGAINST CRAIG ROBINS**

THIS CAUSE came before this Court for hearing on December 18, 2017, on Ugo Colombo and CMC Group's Motion to Amend their Third Party Complaint Against Craig Robins to assert claims for punitive damages, and the Court having reviewed the motion, the responses, the court file and the record, and hearing argument of counsel, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. Upon review of the evidence and proffer of the Plaintiff, the court finds that there is a reasonable evidentiary basis for recovery of punitive damages on the alleged counts pursuant to Fla. Stat. §768.72.
3. Consequently, the following language is interlineated into Counts 1, 3, 7 and 8 of the Third Party Complaint:

“The alleged conduct by Robins was intentional, malicious, and in wanton disregard of third party Plaintiffs’ rights and entitles third party plaintiffs to punitive damages.”

4. This allegation will be deemed DENIED by Robins and no further response is necessary.
