The Petition To Compel Enforcement Of Subpoena Issued To Homeaway. Com by Petitioners City and County of San Francisco, San Francisco Treasurer Jose Cisneros and San Francisco Tax Collector David Augustine came on for hearing at 9:30 a.m. on August 25, 2016 in Department 302 of

the above-captioned court, the Honorable Harold Kahn presiding. Deputy City Attorney Mark D. Lipton, Esq. appeared on behalf of Petitioners. Sanjay Nangia, Esq., Ambika Doran, Esq., and James Grant, Esq. appeared on behalf of Respondent HomeAway.com, Inc.

At the August 25, 2016 hearing, the Court heard argument, ordered supplemental submissions from the parties and continued the hearing to September 20, 2016. At the continued hearing, Deputy City Attorney James M. Emery appeared for Petitioners; and Sanjay Nangia, Esq., and James Grant, Esq. appeared for Respondent HomeAway.com, Inc.

Having reviewed the parties' submissions, considered the relevant authorities, and heard argument, the Court hereby GRANTS the Petition.

There is insufficient support in the record to establish that Homeaway is either an Electronic Communications Service or a Remote Computing Service within the meaning of the Stored Communications Act. There is insufficient evidence to show that the subpoena was burdensome or overbroad. The subpoena does not violate First Amendment rights. The Court does not need to reach the issue of the City's authority under the hotel tax. The subpoena is sufficiently related to the tax ordinances to permit the subpoena to be enforced.

This order is stayed until November 21, 2016, to allow for appellate review by respondent. IT IS SO ORDERED.
