On this day, came to be considered, Defendants, Volkswagen Group of America, Inc., Volkswagen Group of America Chattanooga Operations, LLC, Audi of America, LLC, and Porsche Cars North America, Inc., Motion for Summary Judgment and Special Exceptions, filed December 8, 2017, and after consideration of the responses, replies, evidence, authorities, and arguments of counsel, the Court rules as follows:

1. The Court GRANTS the Motion with regard to the Plaintiffs' "Original" Tampering claims under 42 U.S.C. § 7543.

5. The Court DENIES the Motion with regard to claims under 30 T.A.C.
