The motion is GRANTED. 18 The hearing was begun by Magistrate Judge Donna Ryu and continued before me as a 19 duty matter due to the temporary unavailability of the defendant. The defendant is presently 20 21 detained in pretrial custody in a quarantined housing unit at Santa Rita Jail. 22 The basis to reopen the detention hearing is under 18 U.S.C. § 3142(f)(2). New information not known at the time of the initial detention hearing has been presented that 23 24 has a material bearing on the issues of detention or release. The new information is: (1) Max Ramirez agreed to be a surety and was approved by Magistrate Judge Ryu on March 31; (2) 25 26 defendant has an available residence with Norma Andrade in Tracy, California; and (3) the 27 COVID-19 pandemic, and twelve confirmed inmate cases at Santa Rita Jail as of April 9, makes the jail a less safe placement than was known before. 28

The conditions of release are those set forth in the bond form signed March 31, 2020, by Max Ramirez. Defendant is ordered to reside with Norma Andrade in Tracy and may not change residence without advance approval by Pretrial Services. A further telephonic status hearing is set April 16 at 1:30 p.m. before Magistrate Judge Cousins on phone 888.684.8852, passcode 1557087. Pretrial Services is ordered to provide a copy of this order and the conditions of release to defendant. This release order is effective immediately.
