DECLARATION OF JOHN R. BUND II IN SUPPORT PLAINTIFFS' MOTION TO SUBSTITUTE PARTY PURSUANT TO FRCP 17(a)

JOHN R. BUND II, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, declares:

- 1. This declaration is based upon my personal knowledge, and I am competent to testify to the matters asserted herein.
- 2. In 2011 my father, Richard C. Bund, passed away. My father's estate's only significant asset was his home located at 2485 Timaru Lane, Oak Harbor, WA.
- 3. Because I live in Washington while my brother, Richard S. Bund, lives out of state and couldn't really manage the affairs of the estate or the Timaru Lane property, I agreed to serve as the personal representative or executor of my father's estate. A true and correct copy of my father's estate and probate documents (including the documents appointing me as

personal representative) have, to my knowledge, been provided to Safeguard and are attached hereto as **Exhibit A.**

- 4. In 2013 the attorney for the estate created the Richard C. Bund Family Trust and I transferred the Timaru Lane property into the trust as the personal representative of the estate and the trustee of the trust. It is my understanding that we transferred the Timaru Lane property from the estate to the trust for tax purposes. Attached here to as **Exhibit B** a true and correct copy of the Personal Representative's Deed evidencing the transfer of the property, which was recorded with the Island County Auditor on November 27, 2013. Attached hereto as **Exhibit C** is a true and correct copy of the Richard C. Bund Family Trust agreement dated February 5, 2013.
- 5. I have never understood that the transfer (or the trust itself) in any way changed my role or responsibilities in managing and caring for the Timaru Lane property. I have always believed that my duty to care for and manage the Timaru Lane property is as the executor of my father's estate for the benefit of my family members.
- 6. After the transfer, I continued to manage the Timaru Lane property as the executor of my father's estate and ultimately began preparing to rent it out. I managed the property just as I had before the transfer and I paid the bills just as I had as before the transfer. Nothing I did for the Timaru Lane property ever changed because of the transfer for the trust, which, again, I have always thought was just for tax purposes.
- 7. In 2015, while I was in the process of preparing the Timaru Lane property to rent, Safeguard trespassed upon my father's property, changed the locks on the house, and damaged the property. It did all of this without my permission in any capacity (representative or otherwise). Attached hereto as **Exhibit D** is a true and correct copy of my written statement regarding Safeguard's illegal actions.
- 8. I immediately contacted Safeguard about the lock change and identified myself to them as John Bund, the executor for my father's estate, and demanded that they remove their locks from the property and repair the damage that they did to the property.

- 9. I had numerous conversations (via email and on the phone) with Safeguard thereafter where I identified my self as John Bund and repeatedly informed them that I was the executor for my father's estate. Thereafter, Safeguard presented to me a release to sign releasing them from liability for the damage to the Timaru Lane property. The release was presented to me by Safeguard in the name of "John Bund." It does not mention the trust. A true and correct copy of the release Safeguard tried to get me to sign is attached hereto as **Exhibit E.**
- John Bund, executor of my father's estate. It has always identified the Timaru Lane property as being the property of the "Estate of Richard Bund." This is true both before and during this litigation. For example, Safeguard's Work Order for the lock change conducted on the Timaru Lane property identifies the borrower for the property as the "Estate of Richard Bund." A true and correct copy of this work order is attached hereto as **Exhibit F.** All of the other work orders I have seen from Safeguard pertaining to the Timaru Lane property identify the estate of Richard C. Bund. None of them make any mention of the trust.
- 11. That is probably because the lender (who I understand to be Safeguard's client) has always corresponded with the estate (not the trust) as the debtor on the mortgage. I have always interacted with Nationstar as John Bund, executor for the Estate of Richard C. Bund. Attached hereto as **Exhibit G** as an example is a true and correct copy of a mortgage loan statement from Nationstar that was sent to my personal home address in Kirkland, WA for the "Estate of C Bund." All mortgage loan statements are sent to my personal address. They all reference my father's estate. None of them reference the trust.
- 12. I also paid (and continue to pay) all of the bills for the Timaru Lane property on the estate's (rather than the trust's) behalf. Attached hereto as **Exhibit H** is a true and correct copy of the Nationstar Mortgage online mortgage payment and transaction history identifying the "Estate of Richard Bund." I made these payments out of a USAA account in the name of "RCB Estate Account" that I set up to pay the Timaru Lane property mortgage and expenses.

- 13. After Safeguard's illegal entry and lock change upon the Timaru Lane property I made a report of the incident on August 3, 2015 to the Island County, WA Sheriff's Office. On that statement form I identified myself as John Bund and reported to the Sheriff's Office that I was the executor for the estate of Richard C. Bund. A true and correct copy of this statement is attached hereto as **Exhibit I.**
- 14. I also submitted a complaint to the Consumer Protection Division of the Attorney General's Office regarding Safeguard's illegal actions. In that complaint I identified myself as John Bund and gave them my Kirkland, WA home address. I told the Attorney General's Office that I was the executor of my father's estate and identified the address for the estate as 2485 Timaru Lane. A true and correct copy of this complaint is attached hereto as **Exhibit J**.
- 15. Thereafter Nationstar (the lender on the property) responded to the Attorney General's Office regarding the complaint. In that response Nationstar identified the mortgagor for the Timaru Lane property as the "Estate of Richard C. Bund" and copied me on the response as "John Robert Bund." A true and correct copy of this response is attached hereto as **Exhibit K**.
- 16. I have always held myself out relative to the Timaru Lane property as John Bund for the estate of Richard C. Bund as executor. I explain this now to help explain why I have proceeded in this litigation as executor of my father's estate, rather than trustee of my father's trust. I did not bring this case on the estate's behalf instead of the trust for any nefarious reason. I did so because I have always managed the property as the estate's representative, even after it was transferred to the trust. It honestly never even occurred to me that the trust had anything to do with the case.
- 17. I understand now that Safeguard is trying to allege that I have somehow deceived them and committed fraud on the Court regarding my role regarding the care and management of the Timaru Lane property. I admit that I do not understand the relevance of any distinction between my role as trustee of the Richard C. Bund Family Trust as opposed to personal

representative of the Estate of Richard C. Bund. I have always understood these roles to be identical to each other with regard to managing and caring for the Timaru Lane property—the only substantial asset of the estate. This management and care includes pursuing claims for the benefit of the beneficiaries of the trust and the estate (which are identical) against Safeguard for the illegal entry and lock change they conducted in 2015. I remain committed to holding Safeguard accountable for its illegal actions in both of my representative capacities.

- I apologize to the Court for any confusion that I may have caused regarding my role as both trustee and personal representative relative to the Timaru Lane property. The first time that I became aware that the Richard C. Bund Family Trust could have anything to do with this litigation was when Safeguard issued discovery requests that referenced the trust. Soon after, Safeguard started issuing subpoenas to all of my family members, including my children, nieces, and nephews. I was shocked and upset to learn of this as my family have never had any management or oversight of my father's estate, the trust, or the property. My family members tell me that they have sent objections to these subpoenas, but Safeguard has responded by claiming that it will hold them in contempt of court and subject them to fines, costs, and "more serious consequences."
- 19. Once I learned that the trust could be relevant to this case, I immediately gave permission to my counsel in this matter to speak directly to my legal counsel for the estate, Mr. Charles Arndt. I understand that Mr. Arndt has provided a declaration in this matter confirming that my role as personal representative of the Estate of Richard C. Bund is identical to my role as trustee of the Richard C. Bund Family Trust. I also understand that Mr. Arndt's declaration confirms that I have always acted on behalf of the estate and the trust and that my family members have not been actively involved in managing or making decisions regarding the estate, the trust, or the Timaru Lane Property. I continue to be baffled and frustrated that Safeguard is seeking to depose my family members when they have been repeatedly informed that my family members have no involvement in the management of the estate, trust, or the Timaru Lane property and my family members and legal counsel have informed them of this repeatedly. I

think Safeguard is doing all of this to harass me and scare me away from making sure that my father's estate/trust (and therefore ultimately my family members) are compensated for Safeguard's illegal actions.

- 20. I have been actively engaged in pursuing claims against Safeguard for their illegal entries and lock changes for over three years now. To me, this difference between the estate as owner of the property and the trust as owner of the property is merely a formal difference. There is no real difference in the facts that matter. Safeguard still entered the Timaru Lane property without my permission or legal authority in 2015. Safeguard still drilled out and destroyed the locks, forcibly entered the property, stole personal items, and damaged the Timaru Lane home. Safeguard still possessed the property and prohibited me from doing so. And that property is still owned by an entity with my family members as beneficiaries and me as its representative in all of the identical roles and percentages.
- 21. I remain ready and willing to continue to represent the claims of the Timaru Lane property regardless of whether that is as the personal representative of the Estate of the Richard C. Bund estate or as trustee of the Richard C. Bund Family trust, as well as on behalf of the approximately 19,000 class members that have had illegal entries and lock changes conducted against them. I will continue to keep up with the litigation, work with my attorneys, and respond to discovery in any capacity.
- 22. I apologize again to the Court for any confusion this may have caused and I sincerely hope this issue does not allow Safeguard to escape its liability to me, my family members, and the thousands and thousands of class members that I am representing.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington that the foregoing is true and correct.

THIS TRUST AGREEMENT, dated this _____ day of February, 2013, between John R. Bund, Personal Representative of the Estate of Richard C. Bund, as grantor (the "Grantor"), and John R. Bund, as trustee (the "Trustee"), provides:

ARTICLE 1: The Trust Estate

In addition to the assets described on schedule A attached hereto, property may be added to this Trust, at any time, and from time to time, by Grantor, or by any person or persons, by inter vivos or testamentary transfer or by insurance contract or trust designation. The assets described on Schedule A and all property hereinafter added to this Trust shall constitute the Trust Estate, and shall be held managed and distributed as hereinafter provided.

ARTICLE 2: Purpose of Trust

The Richard C. Bund Family Trust is established for the purpose of managing and distributing the residual assets of the Estate of Richard C. Statement regarding Safeguard Properties breaking and entering

This statement is provide by John R Bund II Executor for the Estate

On July 11, 2015 I drove to the Estate home to meet with contractors to obtain bids for repairs. The purpose was to prepare the house for rent. When I arrived at the house I noticed stickers on the garage door and man door adjacent to the garage door. Additionally, my key would not unlock the door. After reading the information on the stickers it was apparent someone had changed the lock. Also, my pad lock I had on the tools shed was gone and a new one was in its place. I walked to the front door to find a lock box and another information sticker. I walked around the remainder of the house to find a pad lock on the crawl space door.

I called the number on the sticker and spoke to a woman who would not give her name. She said I need to call the mortgage company for more information. And she hung up. I called the second number and no one was there – this was on a Saturday.

On Monday July 13th I called Nationstar. I was transferred three times and I had to call back three times. Each time I was transferred to someone else who could not find anyone to talk to. At one point I was transferred to the Preservation Department, or so I was told. All that happened was a voice mail where I left a message. I never received a call back.

On July 15th I called again and spoke to someone named "Johnny". I explained the damage to the door, the lack of access, and I expected Nationstar replaced the door and provide access. I ask to speak with a supervisor but they were all "busy". I ask to speak to a supervisor on the July 13th call and they were too "busy". Johnny's central focus was getting the missing mortgage payments rather than solving the access issue. I explained, as I had on the 13th, that a trip to the property for me was a 2 hour drive each way. Johnny placed me on hold as he said he wanted to talk to someone about the lock change and what could be done. When he came back online he said he had sent an email to the Preservation Dept and I should hear back from them in 24 hours (I as told the same thing in the July 13th call) – I never received a call back or an email or postal mail. He did tell me that the combination for the lock box was the last four digits of the account social security number or the account number. When we discussed the mortgage payment he noted the late fees and a \$30 charge. I do not know if that was for a recording fee or to pay for the door lock that was changed. I told him I was making the payment as I had told Nationstar of my plans in the Jan 27th call.

On the 18th I drove out to Oak Harbor but there was a major traffic accident in Mt Vernon

and traffic was routed through La Conner. Since there was too much traffic to make the trip in a reasonable length of time I turned around and went home. Lost 3 ½ hours that day.

On the 19th I drove out to the house. I examined the lock box and discovered the lock box had three tumbler wheels for setting the lock and the wheels had letter not numbers. So, another wasted trip. I call Safeguard Properties to get the access code for the lock box and they had not information from Nationstart to provide me access to the house. So, again I could not access the house to have contractors get in to provide a bid. I found out in the discussion with Safeguard that the house had been accessed twice early in the month: 7/2 and 7/3. On the 3rd was when the door lock to the garage man door was changed and the lock to the shed was removed and changed. I told the person on the call that I want to make a complaint for the damage door and lack of access. He made note and provided me with a file number.

I called Nationstar on July 20th and spoke with Xavier. I explained the problem. I ask for a supervisor and of course they all were "busy" - imagine my surprise! I told him had eight hours in travel back and forth to the house with no access; damage to the door and the shed; I wanted a letter stating the house was not abandoned; I am not able to access the house to prepare it for rent or show it for sale; I want a voucher to pay for the door, locks and my wasted time for the past two weeks. He transferred me to Cashea (?) who was could help. She is in Loss Prevention. She was no help and she transferred me to Antoine. He could not help me so he transferred me to Krystal in Bankruptcy. It is important to know that each time you are transferred you are required to provide the last four of the social security number, the account number, my address, the house zip code, my relationship to the owner or the property - I did this four times this day! I had 45 minutes in time just in the verification question process - you know it is really to protect me!! Krystal listened to the problem I was having and I think really tried to find a solution. She noted that what I was experiencing was not part of her work. She told me she spoke to someone in the Preservation Dept and they would contact me in 24 hr – heard that before. And again I never received any correspondence of any kind.

On the 21st I filled out a form at Senator Murray's website. I did the same at the Consumers division of Washington State AG's office. And I did the same for the Jesse Jones show – that was more of an inquiry if he had had any dealings with Nationstar. I received an email back from Senator Murray's office asking me to call them right away. I spoke to Mary Glenn who told me she would place an inquiry to Nationstar. Later she told me she had sent a letter of inquiry to the CEO of Nationstar.

On July 22nd I received a phone call from KIRO TV's Amber Benson, producer of the Jesse Jones show. She told me about the investigative work she had been researching regarding Nationstar and Safeguard Properties. And she told me about a class action suit which was in progress against Nationstar. She told me she had passed along my information to the attorney performing the law suit. Amber told me that my issue was the most blatant action

Nationstar had taken in Washington that she was aware of. She said she had spoken to the attorney and he was very interested in talking to me. I told her was OK to do so. She also ask if it would be OK for her to talk to me for a potential segment on the Jesse Jones show. I told her if it would help others I am interested in the interview.

On the same day, July 22nd, I received a call from Safeguard Properties. They wanted to know when they could meet me to turn the keys over to me. I ask why and they said they were contacted by Nationstar to make the house accessible to me. I told them the earlist would be Saturday at 9:30. I would arrange for one of the contractors to be there at 10:30 to meet me for taking info for a bid. They said Roberto Reccra would meet me there with the keys. He was to provide me a work order for the door fix or replacement.

On July 24th Safeguard left a phone message. The person who called was Beth Abbott. She was calling to find out if I received the claim letter and if I had a bid for replacing the door. She want to know if there was damage to any other doors. She left a message when to call her back and phone number 216 739 2900. I called back and left a message that I had not been out to the house nor have I had access since her company broke into my home. I told her I was meeting someone from her company on Saturday the 25th at 9:30 AM. — I later got a call for the guy I was to meet. He seemed familiar with the house as he ask about the key for the front door and the key for the garage door from the garage into the house. I ask if he had been in the house and he would not answer.

I received a call on the same day from Amber Benson. She provided information about the law suit. She said the next court action would be on July 30th where there may be a decision regarding Nationstar's argument that the Washington State law is invalid with regard to Nationstar's access to residences they hold mortgage loans for. She wants to interview me on camera. I told her it was OK and I would be at the house on Saturday. She said she could not make it that quickly. We arranged to meet on Tuesday July 28 at 10:30 AM. They wanted to have time to put something together for the Wednesday before the court hearing. She wanted to know if it would be ok to send an email to Nationstar about the interview. I ask if she could do that as late as possible. I did not want to jeopardize my chances of getting access to the house from Safeguard.

On July 25th I met with Safeguard at the house. My son-in-law was there as well. He told me the Safeguard (SP) guy did not have the right lock box (I did not understand what that met at the time – I thought it had to do with the three tumbler issue. It would turn out to be something entirely different.) and would have to go back to the office to get the right one. I told him I was meeting a contractor at 10:30 and he would need to be back with a ½ hour of that time. He produced a document he wanted me to sign before he would turn over the keys. I said I was not signing anything until I had access. I ask where his office was located – it is in Mt Vernon; 1½ hours away with not traffic! This was turning into a cluster fuck. I told him to hurry up. He left. I ask my son-in-law if he had seen the lock box. He said there was not lock box on the front door. I went to look to confirm and there was none.

I told my son-in-law to go home as it was going to be a while before the SP guy would return. In the meantime the contractor rep from Great Floors arrived. I explained the situation to him. He said he would stick around since the drive to the house was an hour each way for him. I apologized for the delay. Another SF fiasco!

The for the SP guy left for me to sign would provide them with unlimited access to the house regardless of anything they wanted to do. This included "winterizing the house" — whatever that is. He did not explain what that met. Also, it would hold them harmless of any liabilities. I was not nor would I sign that document in that form. Instead I crossed everything out and wrote I was signing for the hand over the keys to the locks they had replaced. That was it.

The SP guy returned with another guy with him. This I took to be a strong arm tactic to get me to allow them access and sign the form. They wanted to photographic specific areas of the house and the lock box that they left — that was the reason he had to go back to the office; he had the wrong lock box. He could have left me with the keys all along. But instead I and the contractor had to wait for him. The SF guy took a photo of the lock box with the keys. He said Nationstar instructed SP to leave the lock box with instruction to me to leave the keys in the lock box when I left that day. I was going to argue with them but they were younger and stronger guys than me. I felt I would be in danger if I protested too much. I was glad the contractor was there at the time.

So, it came time for them to leave. They wanted the signed form. I told them I could not sign they part giving them access or relive SP of liability. They said both parts of the form had to be signed. I signed only the part that I noted for the turnover of the keys. They started to leave and then came back. They said their boss said I needed to sign both parts. I said let me talk to their boss. They said they could not. I said ok I'll modify the form and sign that. I did and they accepted it. I told them they had broken the law and I was filing a police report. That seemed to be enough to get them to leave.

After I had access to the house I noted the missing items in addition to the damage. I called SP and they would have someone call me on Monday (7/27). I got a call from Beth Abbott if I had an estimate for the repairs. I told her about the missing items and they I was trying to get a contractor out for an estimate. She reminded me of the 14 day limit noted in the claim form. I told her I would do what I could but I was not under any 14 day obligation — more strong arming.

On July 28th I met with Amber Benson and her camera woman at the house. We did the interview. She would let me know if she would hear anything about the court hearing. And she was going to send the contact information for the class action attorney. My daughter Julia was there toward the end of the interview. Amber showed us some of the documents from the court actions so far. My daughter had been working for a law firm in Coupeville until just May of this year. She get the filing information to look up the case and where it

was at currently. Amber said she would let me know if or when they might air the interview.

Aug. 14th – I have not had any further contact from anyone from SP at the house. I cannot tell if they have been there or not. There was a document left on the counter from the times someone from Nationstar or SP were at the house. The notations are bit cryptic. But I understand the basic idea – they were justisfying breaking and entering the house.

It should be noted that when I spoke to someone on the 19th from SP they said they had provided notification by placing stickers on the house on the 2nd of July. I never received any other notifications other than the placement of stickers on the house. Nationstar has my home address in Kirkland and I had told them in the past I live 2 hrs from the house. SP broke into the house on July 3rd and change the locks that day. I ask the person on the phone if they understood the agreement within the Deed of Trust for reasonable notification. He had no idea what that was nor was he concerned with the legal implications of the document. It simply was not his problem.



This Statement is for the residence at 2485 Timaru Lane, Oak Harbor, WA 98277. I am Executor for the Estate of Richard C Bund.

On or about July 3rd, 2015 the residence was broken into by Safeguard Properties. Safeguard Properties replaced the door lock for the garage man door between the outside of the house and the inside of the garage. The process of breaking into the garage required the use of force which resulted in permanent damage to the garage man door. The door is a steel door which is insulated. Attached are photographs of the damaged door and the remains of the existing door locking mechanism. Additionally, the pad lock I had placed on the tool shed door was removed by force and damage was caused to the latching device for the shed. A pad lock was placed on the access door to the crawl space access. No lock was previously placed on this door. A "lockbox" was placed at the front entry door to the residence.

The reason I know that it was Safeguard Properties who performed the breaking and entering was because of the stickers placed on the garage man door, the garage door and the front entry door (please see attach photographs). They confirmed, in conversation by phone and later in person, they had performed the act of breaking and entering. They stated they performed the breaking and entering as well as the door lock replacement as directed by Nationstar Mortgage Company. This statement shall include Nationstar Mortgage Company as a party to the breaking and illegal entry to the residence.

At no time was Safeguard Properties and / or Nationstar Mortgage Company granted access to the property. There was no lawful notification provided as required by the Deed of Trust.

In addition to the damage and unlawful entry to the residence is attached the Island County Sheriff's Property Report document.
