

The United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit having certified to the Supreme Court the following question of law pursuant to  $\underline{\text{Rule}}$  2:12A-3:

Whether, under the Faulkner Act, a council may remove the Solicitor/Director of the Township's Law Department based on an expressed loss of trust and confidence for behavior that did not violate any of the ethical rules governing his conduct, and was not contrary to law.

And the Court having considered the matter and having determined, respectfully, to reject the question;
