The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB Docket Nos. 22-104, 22-121, 22-124, and 22-125, recommending on the records certified to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-4(f) (default by respondent) that **John Charles Allen**, formerly of **New Brunswick**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1995, and who has been suspended from the practice of law since July 6, 2021, be disbarred;

And respondent's brief in this matter having been due on December 19, 2022, and respondent not having filed a brief;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **John Charles Allen** show cause before this Court on May 29, 2024, at a time to be determined by the Court, in the Supreme Court courtroom, Hughes Justice Complex, Trenton, why respondent should

not be disbarred or otherwise disciplined; and it is further

ORDERED that the Director of the Office of Attorney Ethics, or the Director's designee, present this matter to the Court; and it is further

ORDERED that no further briefs shall be accepted; and it is further

ORDERED that the schedule set forth in this Order to Show Cause is peremptory and no further extensions will be granted; and it is further

ORDERED that the respondent's suspension from practice pursuant to the orders of this Court shall continue pending further order of the Court; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall continue to be restrained and enjoined from practicing law during the period of respondent's suspension and shall continue to comply with Rule 1:20-20 dealing with suspended attorneys.
