The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 23-069, recommending on the record certified to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-4(f) (default by respondent) that **John Charles Allen**, formerly of **New Brunswick**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1995, and who has been suspended from the practice of law since July 6, 2021, be disbarred;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **John Charles Allen** show cause before this Court on May 29, 2024, at a time to be determined by the Court, in the Supreme Court courtroom, Hughes Justice Complex, Trenton, why respondent should not be disbarred or otherwise disciplined; and it is further

ORDERED that the Director of the Office of Attorney Ethics, or the Director's designee, present this matter to the Court; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall file an original and eight copies of

respondent's brief with the Clerk of the Court and serve two copies of the brief on the Office of Attorney Ethics on or before March 15, 2024, and the Office of Attorney Ethics shall serve and file a responding brief on or before April 15, 2024; and it is further

ORDERED that the schedule set forth in this Order to Show Cause is peremptory and no further extensions will be granted; and it is further

ORDERED that the respondent's suspension from practice pursuant to the orders of this Court shall continue pending further order of the Court; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall continue to be restrained and enjoined from practicing law during the period of respondent's suspension and shall continue to comply with Rule 1:20-20 dealing with suspended attorneys.
