The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 23-035, recommending on the basis of a disciplinary stipulation that **Robert P. Weinberg** of **Bayonne**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1967, should be reprimanded for violating RPC 1.15(a) (comingling business funds with trust funds), RPC 1.15(d) (failing to comply with recordkeeping requirements of Rule 1:21-6), and RPC 5.3(a), (b), and (c) (failing to supervise a nonlawyer employee);

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Robert P. Weinberg** is hereby reprimanded; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
